 - Addresses DA position on
 - Regulatory Drivers
 - Use of existing technical guidance
 - VI pathway assessment procedures
 - Considerations for buildings, undeveloped property, transferred property
 - 5 year review considerations

 - 5 Year Review Reports
 - Scopes of work and work plans



USACE EM CX Activities

- Comments/concerns reflect
 - CSMs rarely account for the VI pathway
 - Few projects with obvious VI problems
 - Resolution of potential VI problems require multidisciplinary input and planning.
