- *6 November 2006 Interim VI Policy*
- *Updated Final VI Policy*
  - *ASA ESOH Signature (Fall/Winter '09/'10)*
  - *Addresses DA position on*
    - *Regulatory Drivers*
    - *Use of existing technical guidance*
    - *VI pathway assessment procedures*
    - *Considerations for buildings, undeveloped property, transferred property*
    - *5 year review considerations*

- *DA Policy Development*
- *Doc. Review and Tech. Assistance for VI Concerns*
  - *CERCLA and RCRA Project Documents*
  - *5 Year Review Reports*
  - *Scopes of work and work plans*



# USACE EM CX Activities

- *Comments/concerns reflect*
  - *CSMs rarely account for the VI pathway*
  - *Few projects with obvious VI problems*
  - *Resolution of potential VI problems require multidisciplinary input and planning.*
